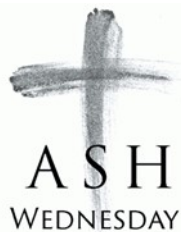
Every Sunday after church there's always room for continued fellowship with an "Eat & Greet" for guests and visitors at local eateries. All are welcome....
